Donor Information

We use one or more third party financial institutions to process credit card and/or ETF donations. They receive your credit card and bank information to process these donations in a secure environment, but it is not stored by One Hundred Miles.

They may be granted access to the personal information necessary to enable them to do their job, but will not use or disclose the information for any other purpose. We also reserve the right to disclose specific information when we determine that such disclosure is necessary to comply with the law or to protect the interests or safety of One Hundred Miles, our donors, our partners, or others. One Hundred Miles does not sell or rent active donor personal information.
